Pandemicized childhoods: A mandate to transform our legacies

Abstract:

We will talk about **pandemicized childhoods**, a concept devised and adapted to the current context and that makes reference to the set of experiences and adversities that childhood has had to go throughout this critical period. The contents of this presentation are the result of personal reflections generated by the pandemic considering children as mirrors that reflect our realities.

Throughout the presentation, we will try to characterize the scenario that the world offered for children, the conceptual transitions around the pandemic, the identification of the place of children and the discriminatory social responses that have been generated against them.

We will analyze the increase in inequities in childhood and its forms of expression, as well as those aspects of health that transcend the hospital perspective. The gender connection with childhood is a neglected field that needs to be considered. In this complex concert of realities, the achievement of the SDG's and the recognition and fulfillment of children's rights are questioned.

Hence, the need to assume the mandate to transform our legacies considering three pillars of action: the planet, the role of adult society and childhood.
